Novilase ILT

The Rose Breast Center is one of the first in the nation and the only site in the Rocky Mountain region to offer this breakthrough alternative to the standard lumpectomy for breast cancer patients.

Novilase ILT is dramatically changing the surgical experience for breast cancer patients, and Rose is proud to offer this to patients.

Novilase uses Interstitial Laser Therapy (ILT) to treat breast cancer using a minimally invasive breast conservation technique. Instead of a surgical lumpectomy, the surgeon places two probes into the breast. A laser probe destroys the cancer while a second probe monitors temperature to protect the surrounding tissue. Once the cancer cells have been destroyed, the two probes are removed, and the procedure is complete.

Novilase ILT is currently being used to ablate benign breast tumors such as fibroadenomas. It has also been approved by the FDA for treatment of Stage I and Stage II breast cancers as part of a clinical trial. The cancers must be no more than 2 cm (one inch) in diameter.

If you are diagnosed with early-stage breast cancer, you may be a candidate for this procedure instead of having a lumpectomy. In comparison to the standard lumpectomy, Novilase ILT is:

- Done with two needle probes, so there is **no surgical incision**, similar to a breast biopsy
- Sealed with small bandages instead of sutures
- Performed in an **outpatient setting** instead of the operating room
- Needs only **local anesthetic**, versus general or IV sedation
- Takes **less than 30 minutes**, rather than an hour or more for a lumpectomy
- Requires **no tissue removal**

The cancer treatment is localized and targeted into the cancer during your procedure. Your treating surgeon and team will be with you during the entire treatment.
